



**Summer activities for youth at Whitehall City Schools
Summer 2021**

WCS Summer Academy – WCS will offer summer learning academies from June 7 - July 16, located at Beechwood Elementary and Rosemore Middle School (No School July 5)

- KG-1 grade: Early Literacy Academy - 3.5 hours per day June 7 - July 16 (No School July 5)
- 2nd - 5th grades: Math Academy - 3.5 hours per day June 7 - June 25
- 2nd - 5th grades: Reading Academy - 3.5 hours per day June 29 - July 16 (No School July 5)
- 6th - 8th grades: Math Academy - 3.5 hours per day June 7 - July 16 (No School July 5)
- High School: Credit Recovery - in person and virtual options, June 7 - July 16 (No School July 5)

Summer Physical Education – WCS will offer summer Physical Education with opportunities for students to earn their PE credit toward graduation prior to the school year. Summer PE will take place at WYHS from 8:00a - 12:00p on June 7 - July 2.

Summer Health- WCS will offer students online health with opportunities to earn their health credit (½). This will run from 8:00a-12:00 Monday-Thursday.

WCS/YMCA Summer Camp – This is the summer version of our TANF afterschool programming. Available to students/families that qualify for TANF funding. This program provides students with academic support in reading and math while helping to build leadership and social skills. The program also has a strong component of physical activity, health & fitness, and community involvement. This summer we look to support students who will be attending Summer School by having on-site programming until 4 pm for families that need child care.

- Monday – Friday (10 AM – 4 PM)
- June 7th – July 30th at Beechwood and Rosemore
- Sign-ups/recruiting will occur with initial priority for students in Summer School. If space permits, programming will include any student from ages 5-13.

Down's Syndrome Association Summer Learning Academy- This is a partnership between the Downs Syndrome Association of Central Ohio and Whitehall City Schools to provide summer enrichment in

reading, math and social emotional learning for students with significant intellectual disabilities in grades 1-4.

- 4 days per week, Monday through Thursday
- June 14th to July 15th
- 8:30 to 11:30, with supervised lunch after
- 8 students, with an intervention specialist and two aides (provided by SCACO)
- Transportation for Whitehall students provided by WCS

WCS Preschool Extended School Year – WCS will offer summer intervention for those special needs preschool students who have just turned three, have failed to make expected progress on their IEP goals, or who risk significant regression without summer services. Services will be provided by an intervention specialist, an occupational therapist, a physical therapist and a speech language pathologist. ESY will occur at Beechwood Elementary.

- Preschool ESY will be June 14th to June 25th (9 AM-11:30 AM)
- IEP Teams will identify those students in need of ESY

ETSS Summer Program at Kae South- The Ethiopian Tewahedo Social Service agency will use space to provide summer programming for 30 students, with priority for serving children who were a part of the ETSS Learning Extension Center, and Track C students, during the 2020-21 school year.

- Monday -Friday (9am - 3pm for students)
- June 14 - August 6 for students, at Kae South

Lunch - Breakfast not available during the 2021 summer.
