It's commonly conducted in schools, workplaces, and healthcare settings. The goal is to identify individuals, like your child, who may benefit from a more detailed eye examination.
- **Purpose of the Screening:** The main goal of the screening is to catch vision problems before they develop into more serious conditions. It provides a quick check-up on your child's eye health and indicates whether a full eye exam is necessary.
- **How It Works:** The screening is carried out by certified individuals trained by recognized agencies, such as Prevent Blindness. They use age-appropriate, scientifically validated methods to ensure accurate results. After the screening, results will be clearly explained, and if any concerns arise, a referral to an eye care provider will be made.
- **Importance of Follow-Up:** Participating in the screening is just the first step. If a referral is made, it's crucial to follow up with a comprehensive eye exam by a professional. This follow-up ensures that any detected issues can be promptly addressed.
